

# MyVRSpot

From the company: *Upload content to your MyVRSpot account and it can be shared with other users within the school or district, and as such, becomes a part of the district's digital repository. The MyVRSpot system is designed as a closed network environment, making sure that the district always has complete control over how uploaded content is shared, with the district maintaining ownership of all uploaded content.*

Use this link, <http://myvrspot.com/greene> and sign-in using your Google account.

Once logged in you will be on your Home page or Gallery.

Any videos, documents, etc. that you add to your MyVRSpot will be located here.

The platform is very user-friendly.

## Recording a video

You can record videos by clicking on the Recorder tab.



You will have the option to record video or to record your screen. Make your choice.

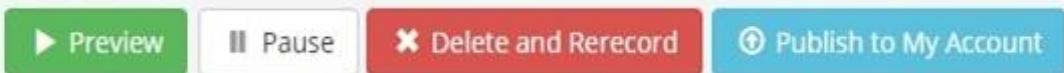
Once you select your option you will be directed to the recording screen. The program will need access to your webcam.

Press the red circle button to start recording. Press the same button to stop recording.

As soon as you stop your recording the video will begin to upload to your account. Depending on your Internet speed and the length of your video, this could take some time.

Once your video is uploaded you will have the options below:

**Video Recorded:** You can preview the video using the play button or clicking preview. If you would like to save this file to your account, click the button below. This video will not be saved unless you click the button below before leaving the page or recording another video.



Publish the recording to your account.

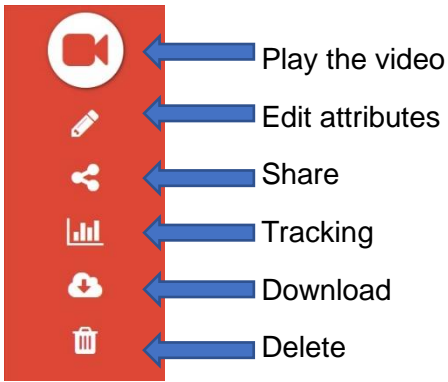
The video will appear on your Home page gallery.

Click on the Home tab to get back to your Home page gallery. You do get a message that you are leaving the site. Don't worry. If you have published your video it has been saved. You can click the option for this message not to show again.

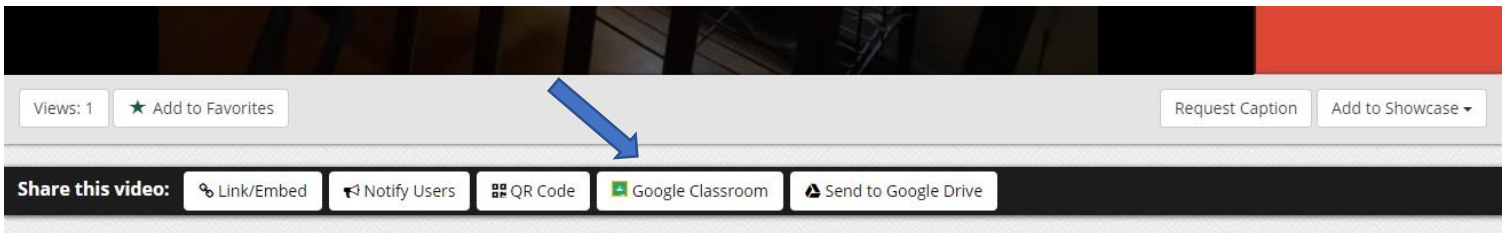
Once you are back on your Home page you will see the video you've recorded. Most likely, the image will show that it is processing. Let it process. It takes time. You may want to do something else while you are waiting. 😊

When the image changes from the processing screen, your video is good to view. When you select your video, it will open to a new page. Here you will see lots of options.

To the right of the video you will see the image below:
