Math

Students will begin to learn about rounding numbers to the nearest 10. They must be able to round two-digit numbers to the nearest 10. Rules are as follows:

Round Down: Ones Digit is 4, 3, 2, 1, or 0

Round Up: Ones Digit is 5, 6, 7, 8, 9

Units

Students will finish their Famous Americans Unit this week and take their assessment on Tuesday. Students will then learn about U.S. Major Holidays such as Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, President's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Columbus Day, Veteran's Day, and Thanksgiving Day.



<u>Literacy</u>

Students will use story elements when reading fiction books. They will need to know characters, setting, problem, and solution. They will also need to know question words such as Who?, What?, When?, Where?, Why?, and How?

Students will continue to learn about nonfiction text features. Students will need to know about titles, headings, subheadings, tables of contents, photographs, illustrations, captions, diagrams, labels, bullets, bold print, italics, glossaries, and the index when reading nonfiction books.

Students will also segment and blend phonemes (letter sounds) in a word.
