HERE'S A LOOK AT WHAT WE'RE LEARNING!

<u>Math</u>

Students will continue to learn about rounding numbers to the nearest 10. They must be able to round two-digit numbers to the nearest 10. Rules are as follows:

Round Down: Ones Digit is 4, 3, 2, 1, or 0

Round Up: Ones Digit is 5, 6, 7, 8, 9

<u>Units</u>

Students will begin their unit on Native Americans. They will need to know the Eastern Woodlands, Lakota, and Pueblo tribes and important information about each. A study guide will come home soon!



<u>Literacy</u>

Students will use story elements when reading fiction books. They will need to know characters, setting, problem, and solution. They will also need to know question words such as Who?, What?, When?, Where?, Why?, and How?

Students will learn about contractions this week. Students will also learn about important vocabulary in other content areas by reading biographies and writing their own biography.
