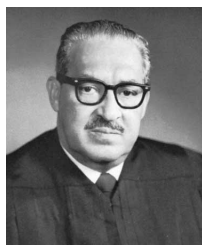
HERE'S A LOOK AT WHAT WE'RE LEARNING!

Math

Students will begin to learn about number patterns. Students need to know how to skip count by 2s, 5s, and 10s. Students also must be able to count backward from 100 by 10s. Patterns test (pictures and numbers) will be this Friday, October 13.

Units

Students will learn about famous American symbols this week. Students will also learn about ten Famous Americans over the next month.



Literacy

Students will use story elements when reading fiction books. They will need to know characters, setting, problem, and solution. They will also need to know question words such as Who?, What?, When?, Where?, Why?, and How?

Students will be learning about nonfiction text features. Students will need to know about titles, headings, subheadings, tables of contents, photographs, illustrations, captions, diagrams, labels, bullets, bold print, italics, glossaries, and the index when reading nonfiction books.
