



Release of Student Information Opt-Out Form

Military Recruiters, College/University Recruiters or Prospective Employers

Dear Parent/Guardian:

Under the federal “No Child Left Behind” Act, public high schools must give the names, addresses and telephone numbers of students to military recruiters, college/university recruiters and prospective employers if the recruiters request the information (P.L. 107-110, Section 9528; 10 USC 503). However, according to this law, students or their parents have the right to opt-out and instruct the school in writing that this information is not to be released.

If you do not consent to the release of this information to military recruiters, college/university recruiters, and/or prospective employers, please check the appropriate box or boxes below. To be certain your wishes are respected; return this form to the school as soon as possible. This request must be updated at the beginning of each school year.

DO NOT release student contact information to **Military Recruiters**.

DO NOT release student contact information to **College/University Recruiters**.

DO NOT release student contact information to **prospective employers**.
